𐀀 𐀁 - Akagụ (Phonetic Alphabet)

n + w -> nw (diphthong) (𐀀)

è -> 𐀁 (intonated vowel) (impersonal subject whom)

𐀁 -> 𐀂 (intonated vowel character form) (impersonal subject whom)

𐀃 | - Ikpokwu (Pictorial Radical Components)

- 𐀃 - Nsibidi Radical - Mmadụ – Human
- | - Nsibidi Radical – Osi – Stick

𐀄 – Nsibidi (Ideographic Character Representation(verb))

𐀃 + | -----> 𐀄 Nsibidi Character – nwe – to have/hold/possess

𐀁 𐀄 – Akagụ - Nsibidi (phonolographic form)

(impersonal subject whom) + to have/hold/possess = one has/holds/possesses

𐀁 + 𐀄 -----> 𐀁 𐀄 (enwe)

𐀂 𐀄 – Okachara - Nsibidi (pure logographic form)

𐀂 + 𐀄 -----> 𐀂 𐀄 (enwe)

(intonated vowel character form) + to have/hold/possess = one has/holds/possesses

𐀅 - Nsibidi (Ideographic Character Representation(noun/homonym)) (enwe)
